



YOUTH SEASONAL PROGRAMS

Caterpillars (for skiers ages 3-4)

Monarch Caterpillars is a weekly skiing adventure designed with lots of play that will help your child foster a love of snow sports and put milage on their skis. Each two hour lesson will expose your child to the joy of our winter mountain environment, and focus on basic skill development both indoors and outdoors. Students will be grouped by age and ability and will be coached by our professional instructors who are trained specifically to teach and guide our youngest skiers towards a positive skiing experience.

Junior Butterflies (for skiers or snowboarders ages 5-6)

Junior Butterflies exposes kids to the mountain and develops all around skiing and riding skills in a fun environment. As part of the program a parent or guardian will need to be present each day. This will allow lift riding and more milage on our skis/boards. In addition to focusing on the child's skill development, the instructor will also coach parents in terrain selection, lift procedures, and successful facilitation of their child's skiing or riding experience.

Monarch Explorers (for skiers, snowboarders, or telemarkers ages 7-15)

This program is designed to foster skill development and exploration. students will be exposed to a variety of options that snow sports offer including free riding, racing, and all mountain adventure. Participants will be grouped by age and ability level and will ski or ride with one of our experienced instructors throughout the season.
